### **Policies & Procedures**

#### **GMGA Requirements**

1. Complete the three month training course offered by The University of Georgia Cooperative Extension Agency.
2. Attend County Orientation after taking the Final Test.
3. Interns: Complete 25 office hours and 25 hands on project hours with approval by the county extension agent.
4. Certified Master Gardener's must complete 25 volunteer hours per year.
5. All Master Gardener's must get approval from your county extension agent for outside projects to count as credit towards required hours.
6. Turn in a completed Log of hours served to the county extension agent by December 31st each year.
7. Attend meeting and workshops on a regular basis.
